lives. In truth, he says we should expect that these times will come.





### OUR AREA REFORMATION FESTIVAL WORSHIP

The Reformation was not merely an event that took place on October 31, 1517. Rather, it was a struggle that took place over quite a number of years, and our Central Conference's Reformation Festival worship since 2017 has endeavored to unfold some of the bigger struggle we aren't always aware of in our Lutheran heritage. This year we consider the crucial stand which Luther took in 1521 at the papal and imperial assembly at the **city of Worms** that would temporarily land Luther in hiding at the Wartburg castle for a number of months to preserve the safety of his life.

**Pastor Mark Jeske** will help us appreciate how our Savior-God gave Luther strength and resiliency in facing fierce opposition to the Gospel's message of mercy and forgiveness. Luther also used his "hidden time" in the Wartburg castle to accomplish some important activities in advancing the blessings of the Reformation, such as his first translation of the New Testament into German, or the very first beginnings of a Lutheran hymnal (1523).


# THIS YEAR'S REFORMATION FESTIVAL OF THE CENTRAL CONFERENCE
